WINTER TENNIS REGULATIONS - 2011/2012

1. HOURS OF PLAY AND COURT FEES

EARLY BIRD TIME - Mon. - Fri. 6:00 a.m. - 9 a.m.

FEES - \$9.00 per court/hour plus H.S.T.

NON-PRIME TIME - Mon. - Fri. 9:00 a.m. - 7 p.m.

Sat., Sun. & Holidays 7:00 p.m. - 12:00 a.m.

FEES - \$11.00 per court/hour plus H.S.T.

PRIME TIME - Mon. - Fri. 7:00 p.m. - 12:00 a.m.

Sat., Sun. & Holidays 6:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

FEES - \$15.00 per court/hour plus H.S.T.

Court fees must be charged to a Member's account **BEFORE PLAY STARTS.**

The time slot from 4:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. Mon. - Fri.. is reserved for Juniors unless Club Professionals state otherwise.

From time to time SPECIALS may be offered for time poorly utilized. The SPECIALS will be announced in the Newsletter and/or on the Bulletin Boards.

NOTE: Statutory Holidays falling on Monday through Friday are classed as PRIME TIME therefore, they do not qualify under the NON-PRIME membership classification.

2. WINTER TENNIS SEASON

Our 34th season will start Oct. 1st, 2011 and close April 30, 2012.

3. IDENTIFICATION

Key fobs must be picked up at the Office prior to playing your first game and a \$10.00 deposit **MUST** be paid. These fobs must be used to gain access to the tennis dome. Lost fobs must be replaced at a cost of \$10.00 per fob.

4. ATTIRE

Proper tennis attire must be worn at all times. Street or black soled shoes are **PROHIBITED.**

5. START AND STOP OF PLAY

Players must vacate their court promptly when time is up, regardless of score. Players should enter the bubble **no sooner than five minutes prior** to starting time. In case a court is empty before and after the booked time, a five minute grace period is permissible. Anyone exceeding these five minute periods will be charged a TRIPLE RATE. Hitting of tennis balls against the sides of the bubble is **PROHIBITED.**

6. GUESTS

A member may bring a maximum of four guests a month at a fee of \$10.00 plus H.S.T. per day, plus court fees and applicable taxes. Guest court fees are the same rates as those for members bringing the guest. A person may be a guest once a week only to a maximum of five times per season. **GUESTS MUST BE REGISTERED AT THE OFFICE PRIOR TO PLAY.** Penalty for non-registration and nonpayment is triple the guest fee.

7. PUBLIC HOLIDAYS & CLOSURES

SUNDAY, DECEMBER 25, 2011	CHRISTMAS DAY (no tennis)
SUNDAY, JANUARY 1, 2012	NEW YEAR'S DAY (no tennis)

8. COURT RESERVATIONS

Reservations may be made by phoning the Club at (416) 284-9251 from 9:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m. Monday to Friday; Saturday from 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. and Sunday from 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. ,or in person at the Office. Courts may be reserved up to six days in advance for a maximum of 1 hour singles or 2 hours doubles once a week (Mon. To Sun.),i.e., to reserve a court on Sunday, booking must be done on the preceding Monday or thereafter. Additional court time within a week may be booked up to 2 days prior to playing time of second booking.

NON-PRIME SPECIAL SENIOR members may book any available court 24 hours prior to playing time.

PRIME TIME BLOCK BOOKING MEMBERS

- Have 5 day booking privileges for other Prime Time courts.
- Have 7 day booking privileges for Non-Prime Time courts.

JUNIORS MAY RESERVE A COURT Monday to Friday between 4 p.m. - 7 p.m., if available, up to 7 days in advance. Juniors may book any court, any time up to 4 hours prior to playing time. Juniors may also book a court for half price 5 minutes after the time period has started upon office confirmation of court availability and timing. This reduction is NOT available if the Office is closed.

9. BLOCK BOOKING AND COURT USAGE

A non-member may not substitute in a group unless that player is registered as a guest and a guest fee has been paid. A maximum of four players per court will be permitted unless instruction is in progress. (See Regulation #11)

10. CANCELLATION

A member must cancel a court 24 hours prior to playing time, otherwise the member booking the court will be billed.

11. INSTRUCTION

Tennis lessons may be given only by the Club Professionals having a contract agreement with the Club.

12. BALLS

A maximum of three (3) balls may be used during play at all times.
